

JORDI CLUA SOBA

Born in Barcelona in 1949, he studied at the Superior Conservatory of Music in that city. In 1965 he founded the group *2 + 1* with his brother and Manuel Joseph, recording and performing their songs throughout Spain, France and Italy; alternated to this activity is added the collaboration with various popular Spanish singers such as Enric Barbat, María del Mar Bonet, Isidor Marí, etc.

He was a member of the Barcelona *Traction* jazz trio, along with Francis Rabassa (drums) and Lucky Gury (piano).

In 1977 he began a collaboration with the singer-songwriter Joan Manuel Serrat, which lasted until 1991, with whom he recorded more than 15 albums, and offered concerts in most Latin American, Europe, Israel and the United States.

Since 1994 he has been based in Argentina, where he regularly participates with various local jazz ensembles and currently the *Albertina Crescitelli Ensemble*.
